



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Attached are the statistics for the month of May 2015. Below are some case highlights which occurred during the month:

Case# 2015-000922 **10230 Haynes Rd**, call came in at 10:10 hrs. as a medical regarding a male subject who was down inside of a storage shed. Officers and Life Ambulance were dispatched and found that male unresponsive. Officers requested Medical Examiner who determined the male subject had expired due to natural causes.

Case # 2015-000928 **10145 Galleon Lane**, call came in at 22:37 hrs. as an Aggravated Assault Family Violence in progress. Male and female were verbally arguing when male subject slashed female victim in the abdomen area and stabbed her in the bicep area with a sharp object. Officers and Life Ambulance were dispatched to the scene. Female victim was transported to Del Sol Medical Center by Life Ambulance. Male subject was booked into El Paso County Jail.

Case # 2015-001042 **424 Melendez Lane**, call came in at 11:20 hrs. regarding an elderly unresponsive female. Officers and Life Ambulance were dispatched to the scene. Upon arrival they made contact with the son advising she had been feeling ill for the past couple of days, the female also had diabetes and taking pills for depression. Medical Examiner was dispatched and found there was no foul play, also stated female passed due to natural causes.

Case# 2015-001103 **Melendez Lane/Nicholas Lane**, male subject called at approximately 10:40 hrs. stating there was a child walking by herself on side of roadway. Officer was dispatched and upon arrival took custody of the child at 416 Melendez. Child was released and a case was opened with Child Protective Services.

**SUBJECT: Discussion and action** to approve a request by TXDOT to change plans for Horizon Blvd. expansion to allow a section of the roadway to drain into a ditch along the City's property behind Walgreens.

**SUMMARY:** TXDOT examined a few courses of action, and has asked us for permission to execute the drain as described.

**BACKGROUND**

There was a flaw in the design and construction of the roadway so a 250' section will not drain into a holding pond vic Homan. There are two possible solutions so that water will drain from the road surface: 1) Rip up the curb, gutter, sidewalk, and part of the roadbed and re-grade it so it will drain as originally intended, to the pond to the south near Homan, or 2) bore underneath Horizon and empty into the concrete ditch along the Socorro "Future Expansion" property.

**STATEMENT OF THE ISSUE**

Option 2 is less expensive for TXDOT. It is a drain from a Socorro street to a Socorro property, so no easement is required. The ditch does not currently empty anywhere. It appears to be a former irrigation ditch for the area, but now both ends are blocked. Area to be drained is roughly a quarter acre. Since its emptying into the abandoned concrete ditch, there will be no immediate impact to the City, and future impact when the land is developed will be very minor.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT** None now. Possible small impact to future development as the drainage plan for the property would be approximately 4% larger.

- 2). Convey the water via a 12" Reinforced Concrete Pipe into the empty lot across the street.


The other option is to remove curb, gutter and sidewalk and rebuild the edge of the roadway.



