

**BID 16-003**  
**City of Socorro**  
**Public Works Department Equipment Rental**  
**Request for Proposals**

The City of Socorro, Texas (“the City”) is soliciting bids for equipment rental for the Public Works Department. The closing date for submission is Tuesday February 23, 2016 at 2:00 p.m. The bids will be opened publicly and read aloud on Tuesday February 23, 2016 at 2:00 p.m. at the City Administration Building in Socorro, Texas, 124 S. Horizon Blvd., Socorro, Texas, 79927.

All submittals must be clearly marked on the lower right hand side corner with your company name and return address on the envelope with the following: SEALED BID-RFP FOR PUBLIC WORKS EQUIPMENT RENTAL-ATTN: OLIVIA NAVARRO /CITY CLERK, 124. S. Horizon Blvd, Socorro, Texas 79927.

Any proposal received after 2:00 p.m. on the date specified will be unopened. All bids shall be firm offers for a period of thirty days and prices shall be guaranteed for one year from the bid opening. Detailed bid requirements are available at the office of the City Clerk.

The City of Socorro reserves the right to waive irregularities and to reject all bids.

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**The City of Socorro requires two scrapers and one bulldozer to excavate a large detention pond. The City plans to work two shifts (=16 hours) per day, six days per week. At this rate, the project is calculated to take approximately 4 weeks.**

**The City requests pricing (daily, weekly, and monthly) for rental of**

- 2 scrapers
- 1 dozer
- 1 fuel truck
  
- The City will provide operators
- The City will provide fuel
- The lessor will provide maintenance and repairs
  - The lessor will coordinate a schedule with the City to provide preventive maintenance as needed
  - The lessor will provide initial response for repairs within 24 hours. After initial diagnostics, repairs will be coordinated with the City's contracting officer.
  - No rental fees will accrue when the equipment is inoperable for repairs for more than 24 hours.
- The equipment will be used primarily in dozer-scraper teams
- The City already owns one bulldozer that will be used in one of the scraper teams

Scraper will have a heaped load capacity of 22 CY or greater.

Dozer will be of appropriate size and power to act as a pusher for the scraper.
